  - Caselite ([www.caselitesoftware.com](http://www.caselitesoftware.com))
    - Time intensive in the beginning
      - Input your schools, teachers, students.
      - For students – input name, teacher, grade, school, therapy plan (impairment, sessions/week, minutes/session, pullout or inclusive)
        - Custom groups, Student availability, rotations
    - Tracks: present, absent, educational activity, holiday, inclement weather, personal leave, unrelated duty, other
    - Notes section
    - District Version
      - Can analyze caseload vs. workload

- Pros
  - Makes a schedule almost instantly!
  - Allows for custom groups
  - Easily tracks attendance
    - Breaks down why service was not provided
    - Gives % for entire caseload OR
    - By individual student
- Cons
  - Doesn't show student progress over time
  - Time intensive initially
  - Tethered to the internet

- When you update your links, their links are updated also.

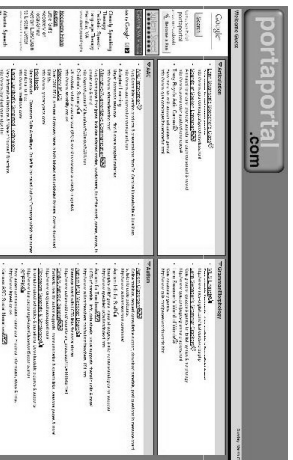
## Online Bookmarking

- Can upload files

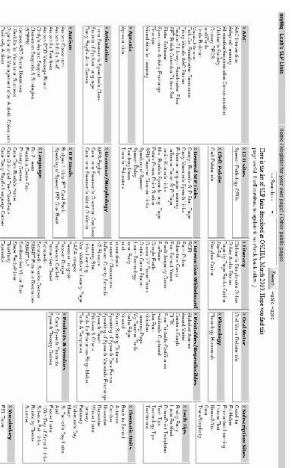

## Digital Camera Tips

- Use the video record when students are doing a given task.
- Playback the video on your computer and have them critique how they did

## When you don't have a Whiteboard

- Connect an LCD projector to your computer
- Access files/internet sites you want your students to work on
- Project them onto the wall/board
- Use a wireless mouse/keyboard to maneuver
- OR use a portable intelliboard

- Turn your iPhone or iPod into a wireless trackpad and keyboard for your computer.

Do you connect your computer to a projector in your classroom? Touch Mouse is the perfect solution for when you want control your computer from anywhere in your room. Touch Mouse is similar in functionality to a wireless tablet with the ability to navigate your computer screen using the trackpad and has a onscreen keyboard to allow you to type in website addresses to simple text fields. You can't however use a pen to scribe something by hand.

Software does require software to be installed on the computer from Logitech. To get the software, go to <http://www.logitech.com> and search for Touch Mouse.
