

**The Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR) may recommend the invalidation of a rule if:**

- 1) the rule exceeds the scope of the agency's statutory authority to make rules;
- 2) the rule conflicts with the intent of the legislature in enacting the statute under which the rule is proposed;
- 3) the rule conflicts with another rule of that agency or a different rule-making agency;
- 4) the agency has not proposed a complete and accurate rule summary and fiscal analysis of the rule;
- 5) the agency has not met the incorporation by reference standards for a text or other material;
- 6) the rule has an adverse impact on business (RC 107.52) and the agency has failed to demonstrate through the Business Impact Analysis (BIA), the Common Sense Initiative Office (CSI) recommendations and the agency's memorandum of response to those CSI recommendations, that the regulatory intent of the rule justifies its adverse impact on business.
